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American Congress On Surveying and Mapping (Colorado Section):

Enrollment in a Colorado university, college, community college, or technical school with a major in Surveying, Geography, Remote Sensing, Geomatics, Cartography, Photogrammetry, Geodesy, or GIS. Undergraduate or graduate students will be considered with preference to full-time students and ACSM members. Minimum GPA of 2.5.

A total of \$1,000 will be awarded twice annually to one or more successful applicants.

Professional Land Surveyors of Colorado:

Full or part time enrollment in the Metropolitan State College of Denver Surveying curriculum with completion of at least six semester hours in Surveying course work. Minimum GPA of 3.0.

A minimum \$1000 scholarship will be awarded twice annually to one or more successful applicants.

Central Colorado Professional Surveyors (PLSC Chapter):

Colorado resident enrolled in Surveying, GIS, or mapping related program. An emphasis on surveying or mapping in the graduation plan and completion of a minimum of six semester hours in Surveying course work. Minimum GPA of 3.0. Full or part time status.

A minimum \$500 scholarship will be awarded twice annually to one or more successful applicants.

Evaluation Procedure

Please submit a short essay, all official college transcripts, and a letter of recommendation from your faculty advisor or one of your professors addressed to the contact for each organization, attached herein.

The essay should state why you should be considered, why you chose your field of study, financial need, personal merit, and career goals. List any academic honors, scholarships, community service, volunteer work, or awards received since entering high school.

Identify your area of interest and how you feel you can contribute to the Surveying and Mapping profession. Outline your knowledge of legal and technical aspects of your field of study and your desire to advance in a profession. Include any applicable job experience, involvement with civic and professional associations, and your plans after graduation.

An oral interview may be required to determine the successful applicant.
